
The carousel is open Thursday through Sunday from noon until 8:00 p.m. starting June 25th through Labor Day. Rides are \$1.00 each.

Thanks to a collaboration of Providence hotels and restaurants, a new Waterfire performance has been scheduled for July 4th. The fires will be lit shortly after sunset (at approximately 8:25 p.m.) and remain lit until just after midnight.

New this year is a dazzling spectacle known as *Stary, Stary Night*. More than 100 blue stars have been suspended from the trees in Memorial Park, next to Hemenway's restaurant.
